Instructions for submission of abstracts and criteria for peer review

1. Presentations must be original;
2. The reported study should be either within the discipline of nursing;
3. Maximum number of presentations by each author: three;
4. There are two presentation modalities initiated by the participant: oral presentation (15 minutes) or poster presentation (5 minutes);
5. Abstracts must be presented in Portuguese and English. The author can send a copy in Spanish or French;
6. Last date to send abstracts in is **June 10, 2022**;
7. Abstracts cannot exceed **500 words** and must be written in word format in the appropriate form for abstracts;
8. Abstracts must include conceptual framework, research problem, method (study type; participants; data collection and analysis procedures; ethical issues); outcomes and conclusions;
9. Abstracts must be submitted on the website:

10. Abstracts will be peer reviewed by scientific committee members that can suggest the change of the presentation modality;
11. Information about acceptance or rejection of abstracts will be sent to the first author before **July 1, 2022**;
12. If the abstract is accepted, the first author must register for the event until **July 15, 2022** and is expected to be present;
13. The first author is responsible for all the travel expenses and registration. If, until **July 15, 2022** registration is not completed, the abstracts will be eliminated from the program;
14. Posters must be printed, legible at a distance of 1,50 meters and must not exceed 120x90cm;
15. The Portuguese Nurses Association reserves the right to publish an e-book and in the journal “Enfermagem” with the abstracts and communications made;
